| Brief Description of Tool / Resource / Application / Practice | In 2-4 sentences describe the purpose of the tool, who uses it, and how it's used to be included in the agenda materials. Project SEARCH, a national High School Transition Program, is a unique, business led, one year school-to-work program that takes place entirely at the workplace. The goal for each student participant is competitive employment through real-life work experience, combined with training in employability and independent living skills. As part of VT's SPDG, two sites were developed over the 5-year cycle and a majority of the graduates are now successfully employed. These outcomes were achieved through partnerships with the VT Agency on Education, Vocational Rehabilitation and the VT Developmental Disability Services. |
