California's 2005-08 State Improvement Grant (SIG2) recently ended, and this document details service delivery and outcomes throughout the time period. The 66-page report has been bound into a booklet and widely distributed to OSEP and California Department of Education personnel, the Evaluation Task Force who monitor and advise our evaluation, and among stakeholders.

This stand-alone document describes ongoing TA activities and summarizes service delivery and outcomes during SIG2. Additionally, because 51% of TA events during SIG2 were in the area of General Education/Special Education Collaboration, we conducted a survey around collaboration which is summarized in this report. Much of this report's content overlaps with the comprehensive SIG2 summary report, but this version is more focused and easier to distribute to TA stakeholders.
