


Matching Instruction to Need for Improved Student Outcomes

What is ABC-UBI?

ABC-UBI is a statewide training initiative to support the implementation of response to intervention (RtI) for academic and social behavior. RtI requires implementing evidence-based instruction and interventions in a tiered model, proactive screening and progress monitoring assessments, and problem-solving to support the academic and behavioral needs of ALL students.

Procedures For Making Application to Participate with ABC-UBI

We agree to the following:

- Allocate district systems coach time (.25 FTE per 4 schools). When a district exceeds 4 schools, more FTE or additional district coaches must be identified and committed.
 - District systems coach participates in statewide coaching network including:
 - Regularly Scheduled Monthly Coaches meetings
 - · Coaches Training/Retreats
 - Electronic communication and information dissemination practices
- Meet as a district ABC-UBI Team at least quarterly which will include the following members:
 - School District Superintendent (or designee), Special Education Director, ABC-UBI District Coach, Representative from District Student Services (i.e. Safe and Drug Free Schools, School Counseling, or School Psychology), Title I Director, and Curriculum Director
- Create district action plan with state team member. Action Plan should include focused efforts to integrate social and academic skill instruction, intervention and scaling up.
- Support the use of one the following instructionally relevant assessments: AIMSWeb or DIBELS for decisions relating to screening and progress monitoring.
- Support the use of evidence based tiered instruction and interventions.
- Support the use of a data collection system for behavior such as Educator Handbook or a district system that provides school teams with the following information:
 - ODR by population (e.g., disability status, ethnicity), gender, location, time,
 referring teacher, # of referrals per student, infraction, disciplinary action, per day per month
 - See attached sample on the last page as an example.
- Support the utilization of the Problem Solving Process by the Systems Level (ABC-UBI)
 Team at each school.

Site Participation Application 2011–2012

- Provide ongoing support for graduated ABC-UBI sites. This may include:
 - · On-going professional development
 - Reviewing data from graduated schools during quarterly district meetings
 - Ensuring high levels of implementation (e.g. SET, Self-Assessment)
- Develop dissemination strategy to establish visibility of ABC-UBI in the district.
- Participate in systematic evaluation of ABC-UBI efforts in schools and district.

We understand that we have additional benefits available as follows:


- Team can apply for reimbursement for allowable expenses after approval by ABC-UBI State Team
