Videos are permanent records.

Infrastructure so people trust the process.

"Digicoach" tailored rubrics for strategies working on. App can be used to self-reflect and can be used by people in different roles. Challenge is getting people comfortable using it.

Not typical for teachers to engage in these processes and they're not comfortable with them. Talking with teachers' unions.

Preparation programs.

Teachers film themselves so that they have control over the video.
