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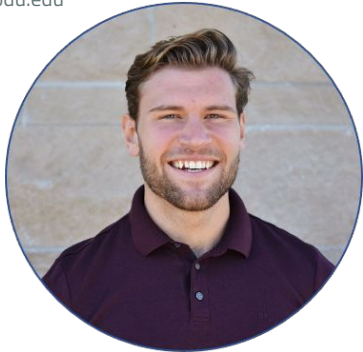

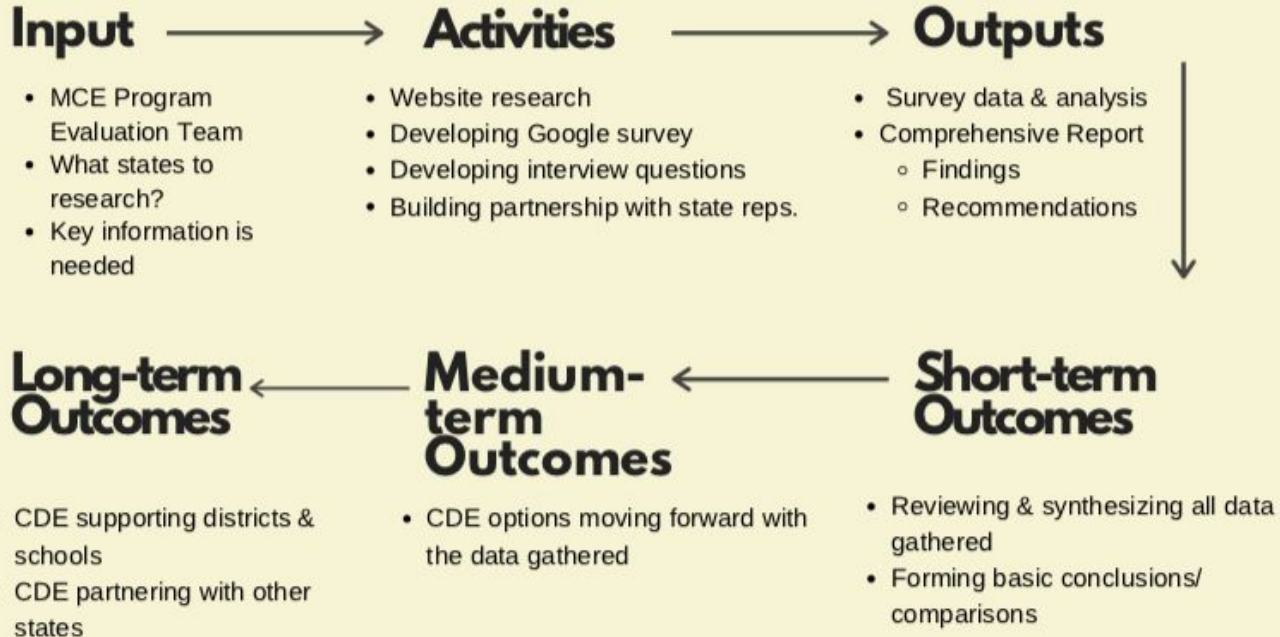

Environmental Elements & Context: COVID-19 pandemic & MTSS funding



Methods

- Process
 1. Review individual states' MTSS website
 2. Compile Google survey results
 3. Conduct follow-up interviews
- Limitations
 - Response rate
 - Timeframe

Key Findings

Tiered Supports Commonalities:

1. Assessing student need & meeting those needs
2. Using student data to increase student success at the universal level
3. Evidence-based intervention specific to individual student need

Platform:

Combination of Canvas and internally developed platforms

Tools:

Combination of internally developed database collection platforms, internally managed checklists and handbooks, and surveys for fidelity

Communication:

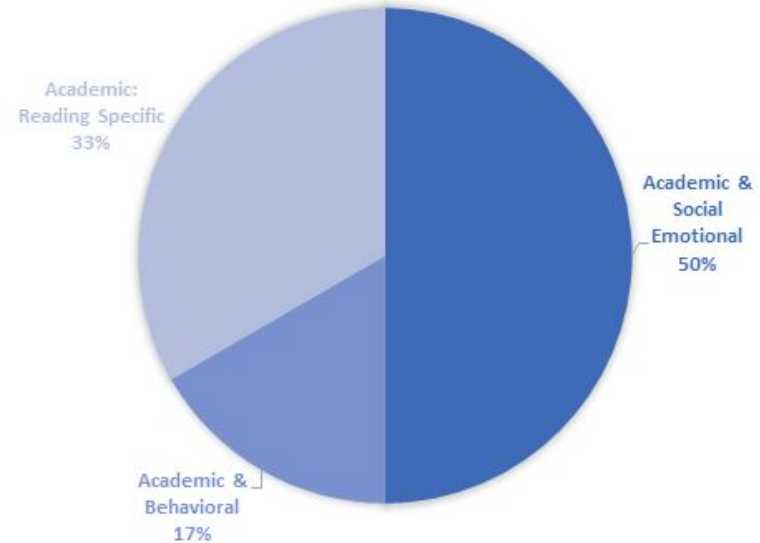
Electronic (Website & Emails) & Conferences

Biggest Takeaway:

Overall, the different MTSS teams expressed an interest in collaborating across states. Given that MTSS teams are all serving similar functions, there is potential for collaboration through sharing resources and efforts.

Key Options for Consideration

- Resource share across states.
 - Training guides, fidelity checklists, surveys, and other tools
- Working together to address new needs
 - As the need for new tools arises, states can collaborate to create those tools more efficiently
 - Incorporate a collaboration/innovation process
- Communication
 - How can states structure communication so that it is beneficial, not burdensome?
 - Team-work interventions

Next Steps

- Positive response to future partnerships with CDE and participating states. Main goals through partnering include:
 - Resource sharing
 - Online training platforms
 - Social emotional supports
 - Regularly scheduled check-ins to discuss individual successes & challenges
