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



## The Year was 2007


- Planning and Evaluation Tool-Revised
  - Elementary focus only
  - Tier 1 focus
  - People were sending us paper copies of their assessment results. We entered those into a spreadsheet on a shared drive
  - Sometimes an inverse relationship with reading outcomes





#### Fast Forward to 2022

- Reading Tiered Fidelity 2.0
  - Elementary and Secondary-Level Editions
  - Tier 1 and Advanced Tiers
  - Greater emphasis on classroom and instructional practices in addition to school-wide systems and data
  - Equity and Family Engagement Embedded Throughout

## Tier 1 Data, Systems, Practices

- 1. Teachers provide daily instruction in comprehension processes across subjects to address the needs of all learners.
- 2. The school leadership team has a documented process for communicating with individuals and other teaming structures.
- 3. Grade-level teams use data to monitor the effectiveness of Tier 1 grade-level reading instruction.

- S: specific
- M: measurable
- A: attainable
- R: realistic
- T: timely
- E: equity focused

## Improvement, not Compliance

- The R-TFI Reporting System is specifically for the R-TFI. We still need to make the connections to • student reading outcomes.
- Example 1:
  - Our student reading data looked like this...
  - Since receiving training from the SPDG, we are using the R-TFI to guide and monitor our improvement efforts.
  - When we improved implementation of the reading components of an MTSS framework, student reading data improved to this...
- Example 2:
  - Student reading data are improving.
  - We are confident the improvement is connected to our implementation of the reading components of an MTSS framework (as measured by the R-TFI)
  - We need these resources from our district to continue making progress and sustain what's been put into place.
