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PURPOSE OF TITLE II

Section 2001. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this title is to provide grants to State educational agencies and subgrants to local educational agencies to—

- 1. increase student achievement consistent with the challenging State academic standards;
- 2. improve the quality and effectiveness of teachers, principals, and other school leaders;
- 3. increase the number of teachers, principals, and other school leaders who are effective in improving student academic achievement in schools; and
- 4. provide low-income and minority students greater access to effective teachers, principals, and other school leaders.




GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT TITLE II, PART A

- Formula grant—USED awards funds to SEAs, and SEAs award funds to LEAs using statutory formulas.
- FY 2019: \$2.06 billion
- Funds may be used for a large variety of activities related to teacher, principals, and other school leaders.
- Supplement, not supplant: ESEA Section 2301



HOW TITLE II, PART A FUNDS ARE DISTRIBUTED





- No required uses of funds
- Multiple allowable uses of both SEA and LEA funds
- Title II, Part A funds may be transferred to other programs, and funds from other programs may be transferred into Title II, Part A (Section 5103)



- Professional Development
- Class Size Reduction
- Recruitment and Retention
- Educator Evaluation
- Induction and Mentoring
- Activities that the SEAs/LEAs identify as meeting the purpose of IIA and that are "evidence-based."



- Annual surveys on how SEAs and LEAs use program funds.
 - Annual LEA survey began in 2002-2003—nationally representative sample.
 - Annual SEA survey began in 2013-2014
- No data collection in 2016-2017 or 2017-2018 while surveys were updated to reflect changes in ESSA.
 - Expansion of LEA survey.
- Data collection for 2018-2019 has just concluded—report expected later this year.
