# About MIBLSI

- MIBLSI provides intensive technical assistance for direct district partners working to install and use an integrated behavior and reading Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) framework
- Direct district partners participate in an established scope and sequence at the district and school levels

# The Start of Our Journey

- Created almost 100 online modules
- Designed to deepen background knowledge in topics related to the scope and sequence
- Not required for school or district teams



# Initial Lessons Learned

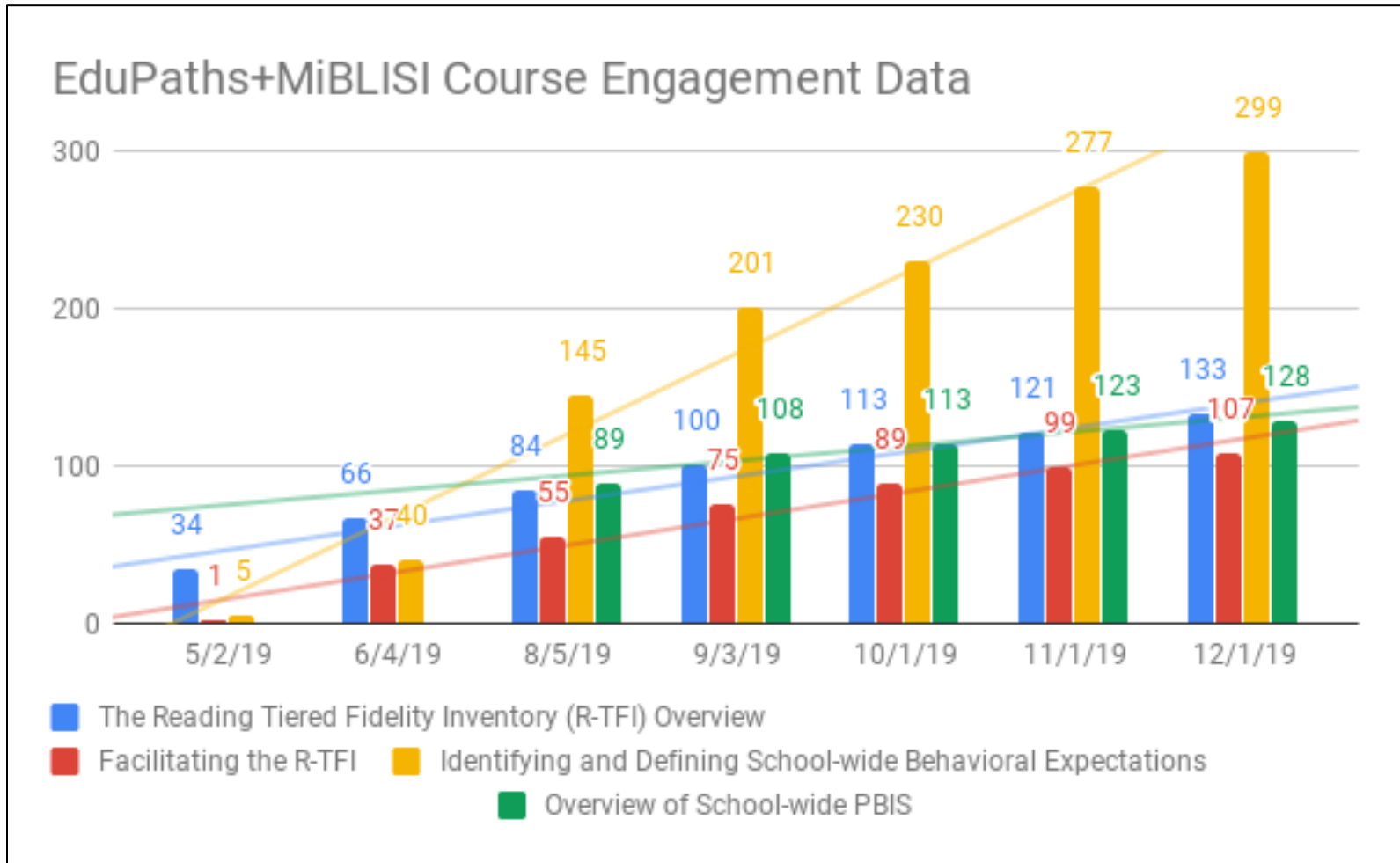
- Quantity may not be the best option for online modules
- Continued learning for our staff to strengthen our skills in developing online modules
- New learning for our staff related to software to support modules

# Our Current Location

- Scaled back the quantity of our online modules
- Using online modules as pre-requisites to in-person trainings
- Designed to support learning of the full staff when the School Leadership Team attends training

- Carving out time that would allow for the creation of high-quality professional learning modules
- Closer alignment between the online modules, the in-person professional learning
- Opportunities to leverage online modules as a part of the Individual Professional Learning Plans for coaches

# Our Next Destination



- Access online modules prior to in-person trainings in the scope and sequence
  - Reduce the amount in professional learning
  - Shift the focus of the in-person professional learning to provide more practice and feedback
  - Use data from the online course to differentiate the in-person learning
