Key Findings

MTSS MAIN FOCUS ACROSS STATES

Tiered Supports Commonalities:

- 1. Assessing student need & meeting those needs
- 2. Using student data to increase student success at the universal level
- 3. Evidence-based intervention specific to individual student need

Platform:

Combination of Canvas and internally developed platforms

Tools:

Combination of internally developed database collection platforms, internally managed checklists and handbooks, and surveys for fidelity


Communication:


Key Options for Consideration

- Resource share across states.

 - As the need for new tools arises, states can collaborate to create those tools more efficiently
 - Incorporate a collaboration/innovation process
- Communication
 - How can states structure communication so that it is beneficial, not burdensome?
 - Team-work interventions
