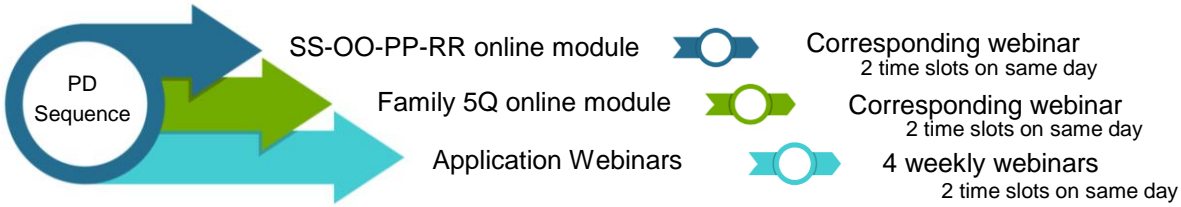


Evolution of a Learning Path

Initial Stages of Professional Development Sequence



Purchased approximately 80 seats in modules through FSU (developer). Simultaneously working with Dr. Juliann Woods (FGRBI developer and principle researcher) to develop modules for PA. This required multiple video exemplars demonstrating application of skills.



Number of Individuals Completing PD Sequence

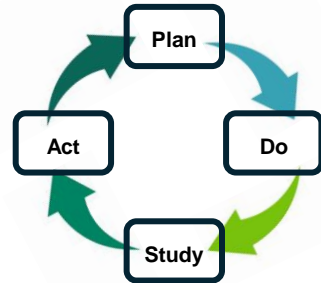
