

## Tips for Addressing Common GPRA Reporting Challenges

### SPDG Program Measure 4

**Measure:** The percentage of Special Education State Personnel Development Grant-funded initiatives that meet their child outcome targets

**Grantees required to report on the measure:** Grants in the final project year

#### **Reminder**

- **Grant year:** Counted from the year the SPDG grant was awarded
- **Initiative year:** Counted from the year project implementation began

Tip 1: Review [reporting guidance](#) for the measure before entering performance data into the ED 524B Project Status Chart

- The guidance includes information about requirements for the measure, information on how to establish a target, and instructions for reporting data in the Project Status Chart.

Tip 2: Confirm that the target is appropriate and achievable

- Each year, the project team should assess the target and determine if it should be adjusted.
- Consult with your Project Officer about target modifications.

Tip 3: Confirm that the unit of analysis for the ratio aligns with the focus of the measure

- For example, if the project team seeks to improve students' reading scores, the unit of analysis (numerator and denominator) should be students.

Tip 4: Report complete data in the correct location of the Project Status Chart

- Enter the numerator, denominator, and resulting percentage in the Project Status Chart. There should be enough information so that reviewers can replicate the calculations.
- Confirm that you have entered target data and actual data in the corresponding sections of the Project Status Chart.

#### **Reminder**

Project Status Chart Measure Types

- **Program:** Represents data for a required (GPRA) measure
- **Project:** Represents data for a measure the project team created
